Dr. Boushy married a Southern belle, a Kentuckian by birth, Edith Asbury, descendant of the famous family of Bishop Asbury, founder and Church in America Mrs Church in America. Mis. highest honors of Wayland College and received the Masters of Arts degree from West Teachers College. They have wo children, Ted., Jr., a graduate of Wake Forest University and John, who is almost a sophomore at NCSUFU at Ft. Bragg.
In 1964 Dr. Boushy came to North Carolina and had six offers in one week, but he choose to come to rayetteville State College when Dr. Boushy wanted to come to Fayetteville State because he felt he was needed and jecause he knew how it felt to suffer. Consequently, Dr. Boushy resigned from his position at Pembroke, asking Dr. Jones, president of Pembroke, torelieve him of his contract with them. Dr. Jones consented and he was able to sign a contract with FSU.
