The officers are Bobby H. Washington, Ronnie Smith and Franklin G. Melvin. All of the officers have received their assignments and will be reporting for active duty during the month of June.

Lt. Melvin is being assigned to Keesler AFB, Biloxi, Mississippi and will attend Communication Maintenance Officer's School; Lt. Smith is assigned to Grand Forks AFB, North Dakota in the Logistic Field; and Lt. Washington is assigned to Lowry AFB, Denver, Colorado to attend the Intelligence Officer's School.

Three additional students will be commissioned in June. They are Frank J. Douglas, Conrith W. Davis, and Bernard Taylor. Both Douglas and Davis will be assigned to the Air Force Pilot Training Program while Taylor will be assigned to Lockport Air Force Station, New York as a Personnel Officer.
