 Most Precise and Original--(Drill Competition)--Reed

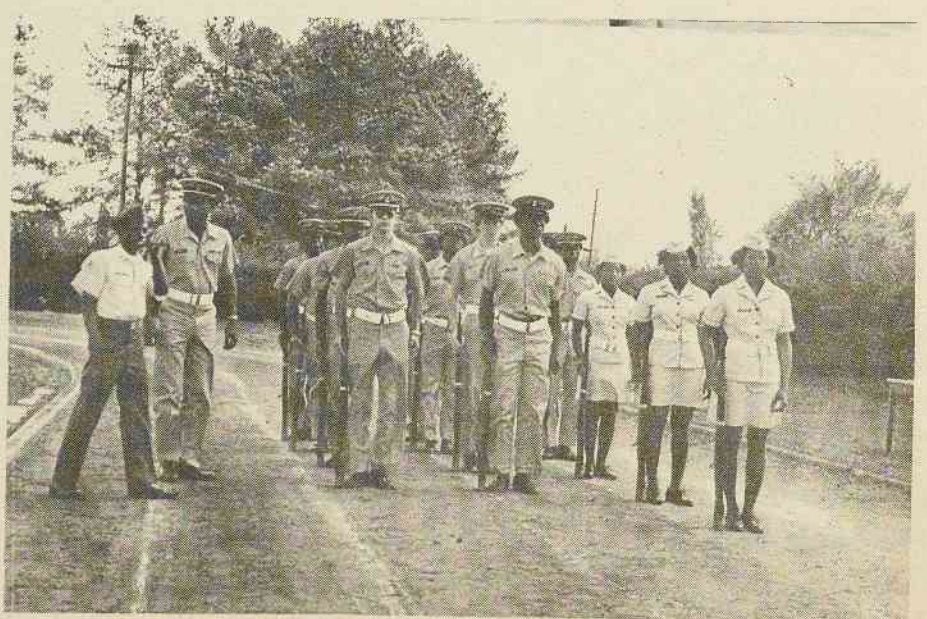
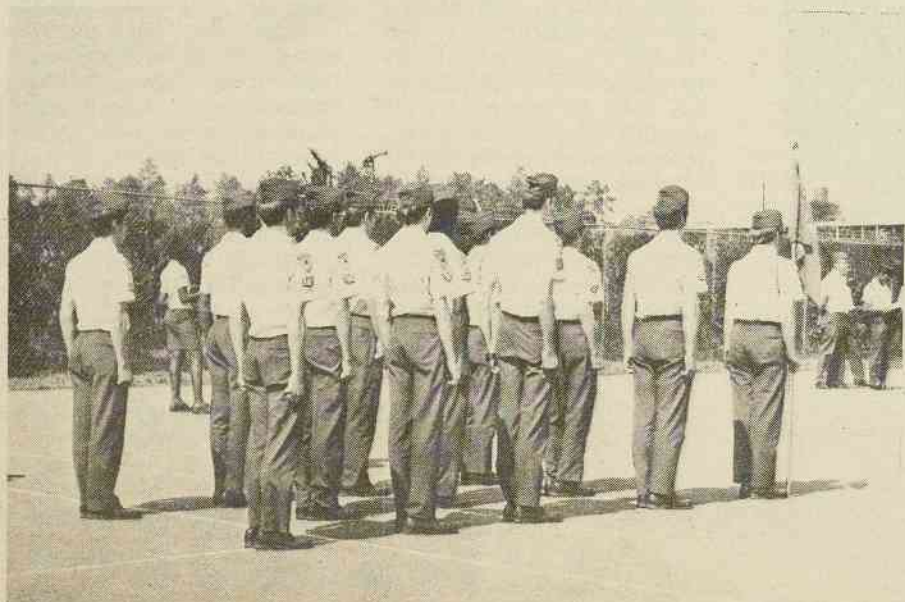
