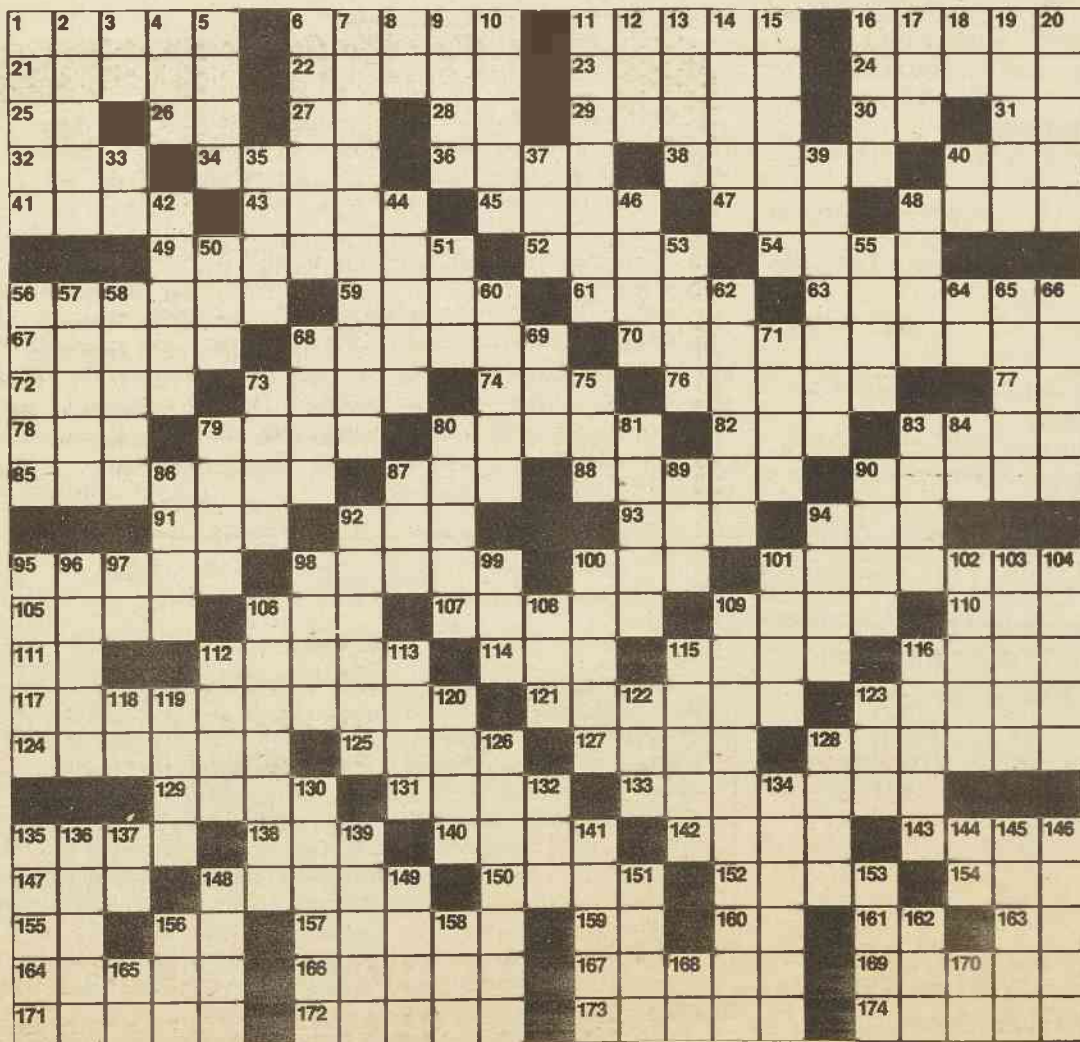

**Throw Another Log On The Fire:** Wood now provides Americans with half as much energy as nuclear power does, according to the Department of Energy. Since the 1973-74 oil embargo, the use of wood as fuel has expanded nearly 15% a year. Between 1972 and 1977, the number of wood-burning stoves in use has increased from 250,000 to 2,000,000. One-fifth of the homes in Northern New England rely on wood as their primary heat source, and 30% more use it as a supplemental source. *Conservation News.*
