Fayetteville State Downs Livingstone For First Win

SALISBURY (AP) - Keeneth Fraizer ran for two touchdowns and Anthony Barnes threw a fourth-quarter touchdown pass on Saturday to rally Fayetteville State to a 20-13 CIAA victory over Livingstone.

Both teams are 1-8. Fraizer's scoring runs, 1 and 12 yards, gave the Broncos a 12-0 lead after they missed both conversion kicks.

Livingstone got to within 12-7 after Cedric Burgess intercepted a Barnes pass and returned it 68 yards. James Simpson kicked the conversion.

The Bears took the lead with 14:05 left to play on a 2yard run by Aaron Geddis, but Simpson missed the conversion.

Barnes hit Anthony Edwards on a 19-yard scoring play on a drive after the kickoff with 11:21 left, and the pair connected on the 2-point conversion for the victory.


