There is a new faculty member in Sociology, Dr. Sung Pyo Jun. He received his B.A. degree in Journalism and Mass Communications from Korea University in Seoul, Korea, his M.A. in Sociology from Iowa State University, and his Ph.D. in Sociology from the University of Minnesota. His areas of specialization are complex organizations,

the sociology of aging, statistics, and power relations.

When asked "Why Sociology?", Dr. Jun said he was motivated to go into the field because as he studied mass communication, he came to view it as a subfield of Sociology. He also wanted to study society and to understand the political unrest occurring in Korea. "Why Fayetteville?" He likes the milder cli-

mate, the size of the University, the proximity to both the mountains and ocean, and it puts him in closer proximity to his parents in Pennsylvania. He likes the cultural diversity of the area and the large number of ethnic churches will allow him to continue his research in that area.
