Opening Plenary Keynote Speaker:

Dr. Christopher Edwards is the Medical Director of the Biofeedback Laboratory and Pediatric Neuropsychology Service at Duke University Medical Center in Durham. He is an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Duke University and an Associate Professor of Medicine, Division of Hematology, at Duke University Medical Center. A licensed clinical psychologist, he completed a two year fellowship in Endocrinology and Psychology at Duke University Medical Center. His research interests are in two primary areas: Pain and Psychoneuroendocrinology. Currently, he is studying factors that influence pain associated with osteoarthritis and Sickle Cell Disease as well as the impact of drugs for pain and Alzheimer's Disease.

Dr. Ingrid Hall is a Lead Epidemiologist at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in Atlanta, Georgia. She holds a BS degree in biology from Duke University, a PhD in genetics and molecular biology, and an MPH in epidemiology from University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She has worked as a cancer epidemiologist in the Division of Cancer Prevention and Control for the past 14 years. She has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals on breast cancer-risk factor associations in African American women and the genetics and family history of breast, ovarian, and prostate cancers. Her current research focus is in the area of health disparities in cancer incidence and survival.
