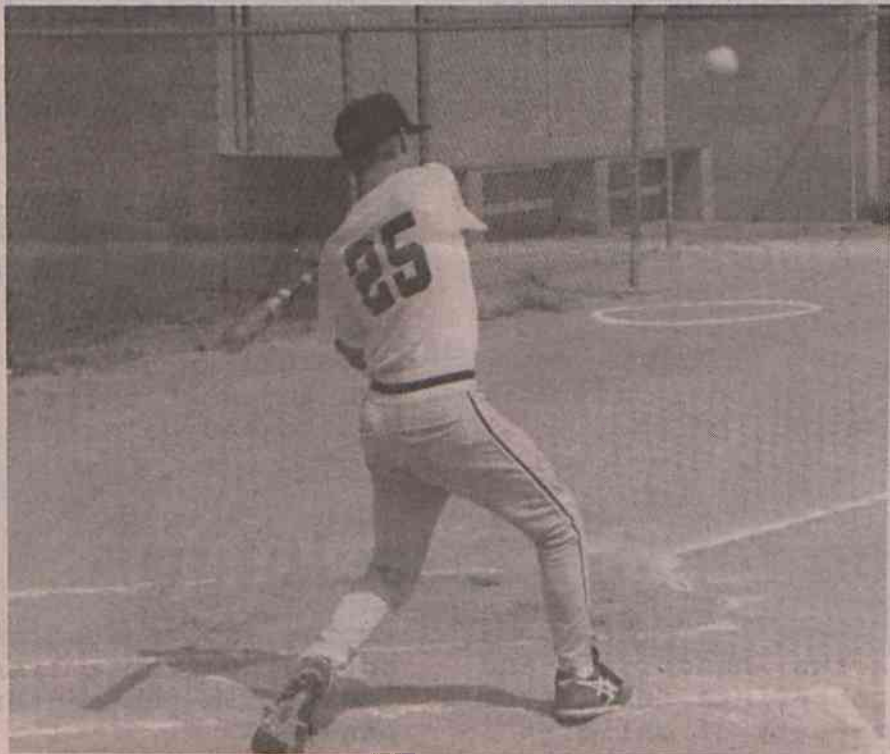
After finishing 2nd in the regular season conference, the 1993 WCC men's softball team captured first place in the conference tournament.

The Bisons were successful against Sandhills Community College; and in the subsequent championship game, concluded with a 15-3 victory.



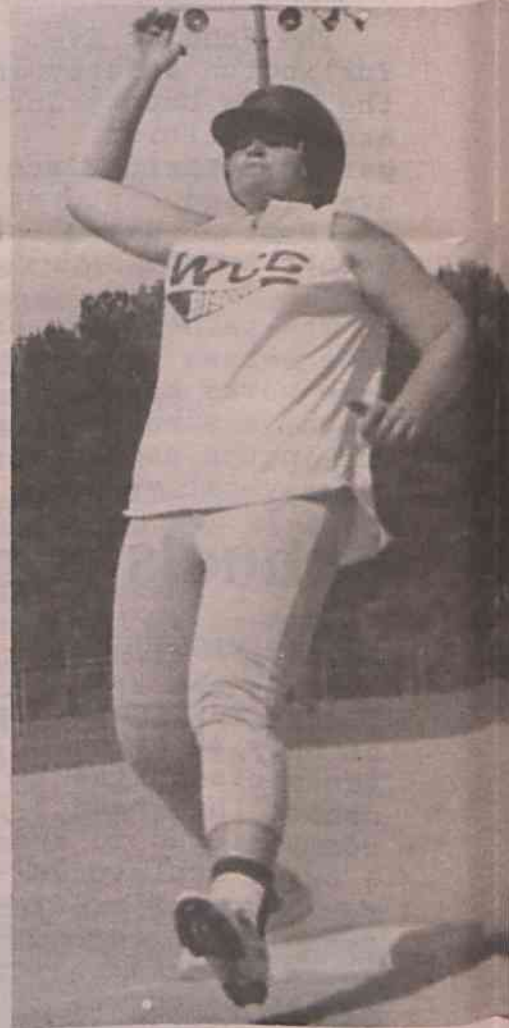

Plans underway to refurbish playing field

WCC students, faculty, and staff can play softball now on a field located behind the Health Science Building.

But thanks to the efforts of Dick Moffatt, that field will eventually be improved with billboards, fencing and lights.

Moffatt, chair of the Building Committee of the Board of Trustees at WCC, has presented a plan for a new softball field.

Moffatt estimates the field will cost about \$15,000.

In this plan, area businesses could buy 4x8 feet billboards for \$300 for three years.

Of that, \$100 would be used to paint the billboards and the other \$200 would be net profit for fencing and bleachers.

The board approved allowing the building committee to proceed with its plan.
