AF Base program grows

In the past 2 years, WCC's program at Seymour Johnson Air Force Base has grown from a low 1991 enrollment to 17 classes and 243 students this spring, according to Coordinator Phyllis Radford.

Ninety-six of this number are active military, 43 are dependents of active military, 101 are civilian, and 3 are civilian personnel, Radford said.

Students take base classes to complete courses in a shorter time than the ll-week quarter on the main campus.

Students also choose base classes because times coincide better with their schedules.

Base requirements and credits are the same as the ones required at WCC.

Base classes allow more choices for the students and enable them to further their education with more convenience, Radford said.




