The Bisons finished third in the conference, and Smith was a conference medalist.

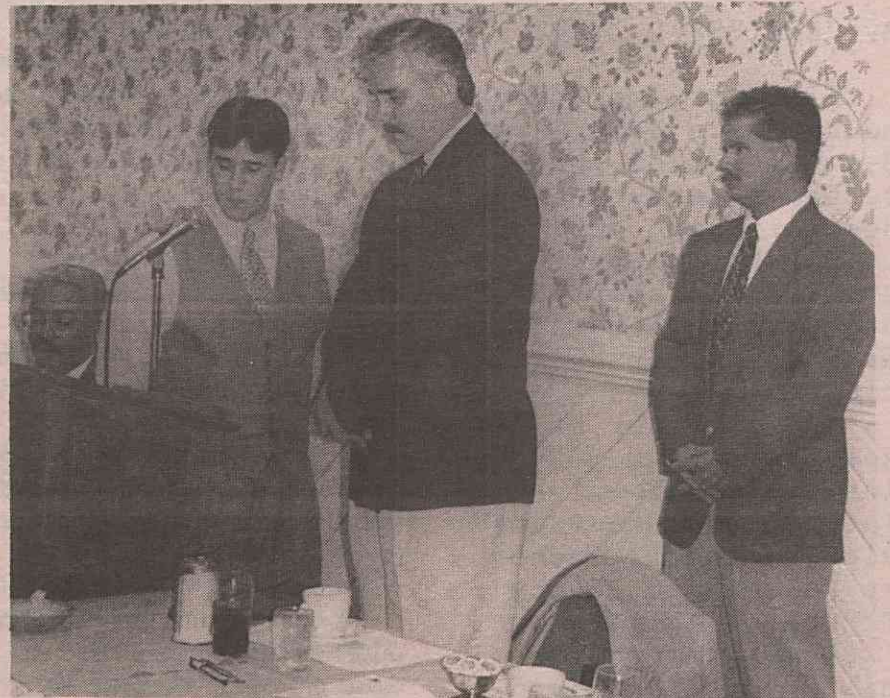
Who's Who members received plaques presented by Jimmy Ford, dean of Human Resources Development and Beth Jones.
