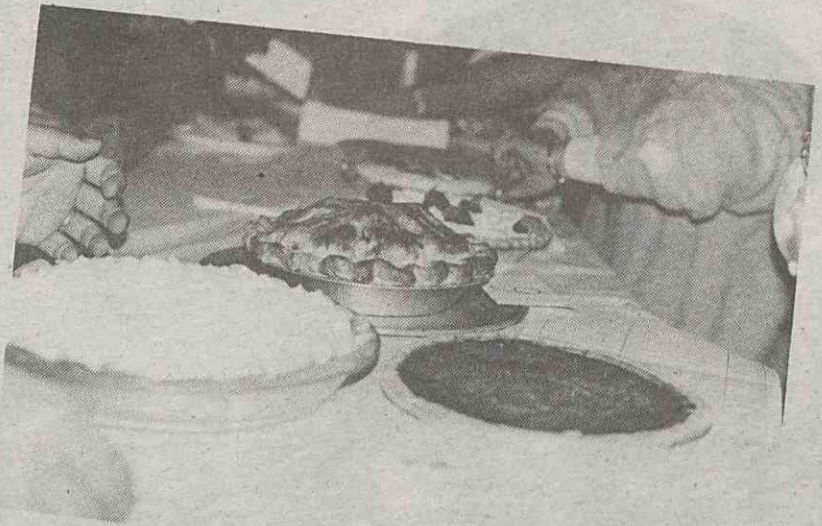




Gene Smith, biology instructor, receives congratulations from Marilou Barab, treasurer of the International Students' Club, for winning the club's Scavenger Hunt event.
