Loftin has a 5 year-old son named Damion. Her hobbies and interests include reading, walking, basketball, softball, shopping, and watching her son play tee-ball.

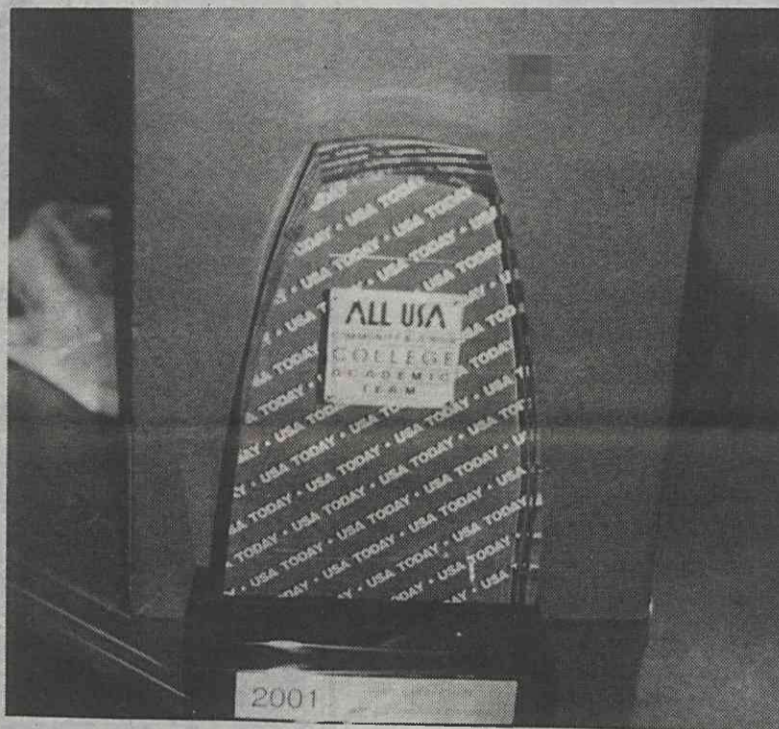
A unique fact about Loftin is that she has a caring heart and she does her best with her child, as well as the kids at school.
