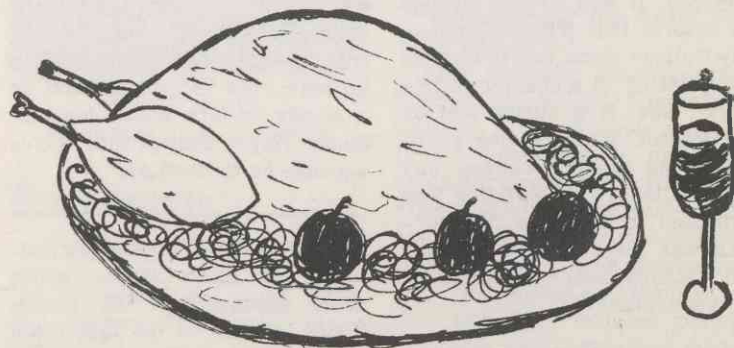

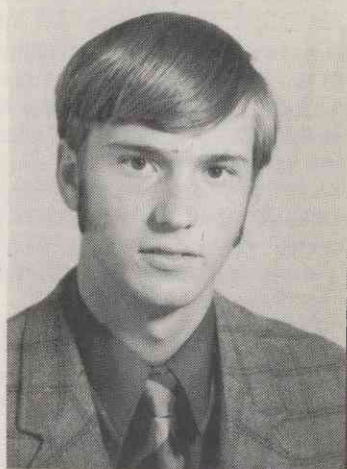


Spoon River Anthology To Be Presented

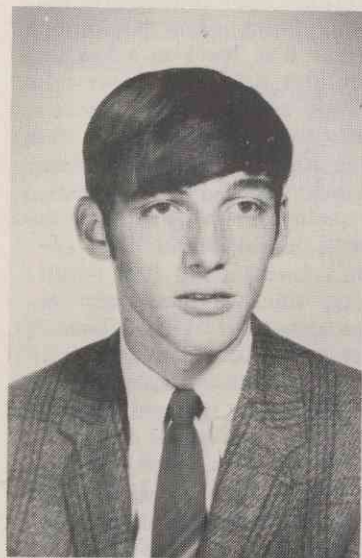
Freshmen Have Elections

The various clients represented in each student gift-pax are--

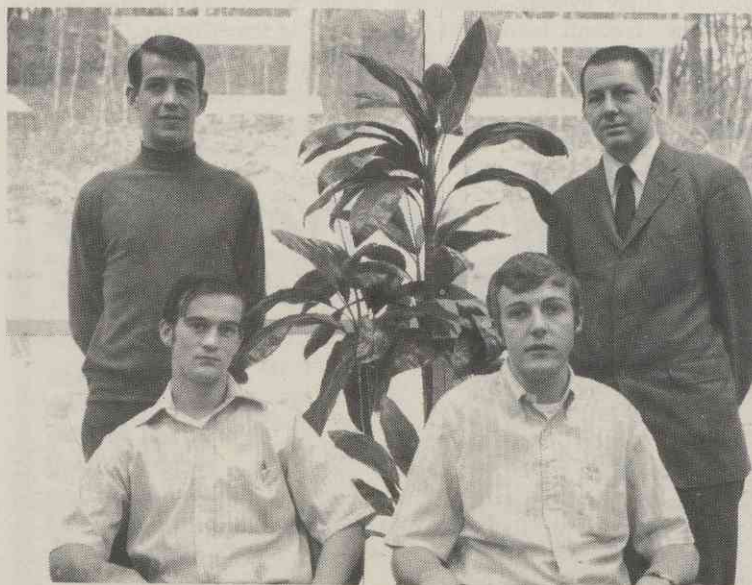
