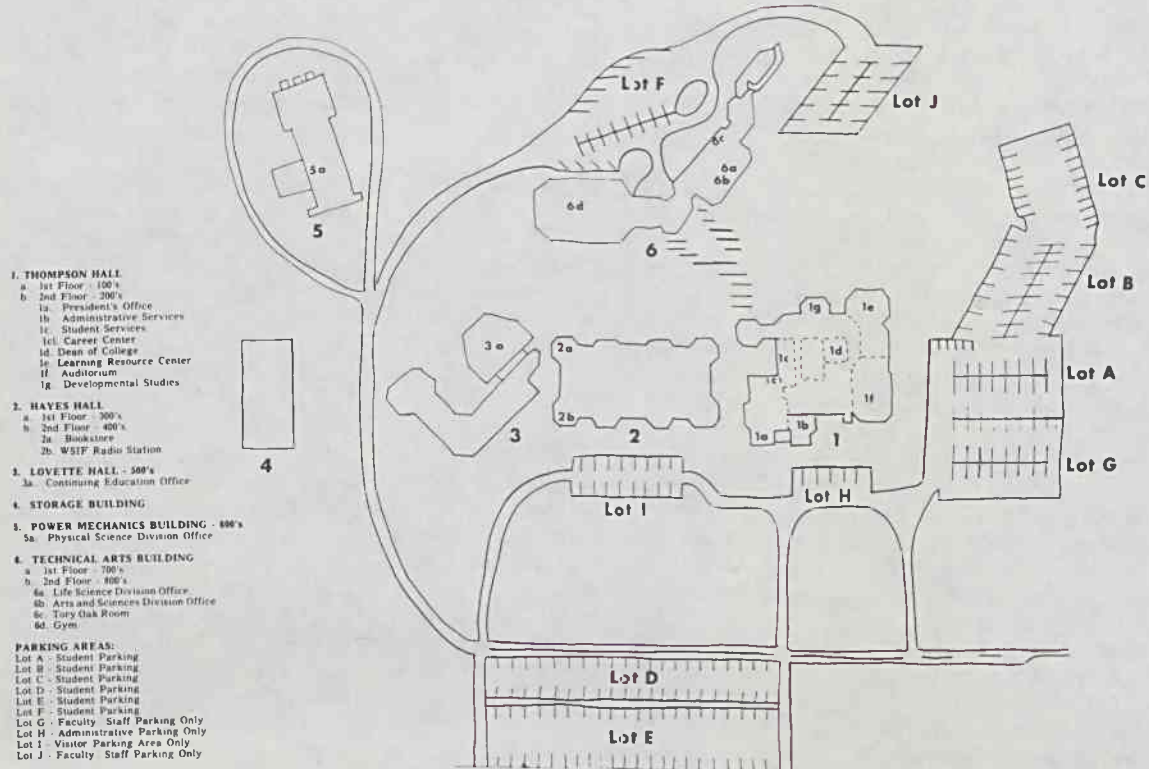


## Our Campus .....



## Parking Regulations

- Personnel operating vehicles on the campus should be aware of the authorized speeds, parking spaces and other regulations.
- The college access road from Highway #268 to the parking lots is under jurisdiction of the State Highway Department. Maximum speeds which are established by the state's ordinance are as posted.
- Driving of vehicles, including motorbikes, on sidewalks and unpaved areas of the campus is prohibited.
- PARKING:** Vehicles may be parked in the following places: Lots A, B, C, D, E, and F: **STUDENT PARKING ONLY** Lower Lot and Lot on top of the hill north of the Technical building is reserved for Faculty/Staff Only. Other: Parking area directly in front of Thompson Hall is for Administrative parking only. Parking area in front of Hayes Hall is reserved for the Handicapped Visitors and Service Vehicles only. (Motorbikes to be parked in visitors lots - Two Per Space!)
- Do not park parallel to a curb.
- "Back in" parking is prohibited due to the fact that it is time consuming and it disrupts smooth flowing traffic and if cars were allowed to back in to a parking space the vehicles back end would be over the median - thus disrupt the mowing of grass up to the median.
- Vehicle registration sticker must be displayed on the rear glass. (Driver's side, please)
- Do not block traffic lanes or other vehicles.
- FINES:** Parking tickets will be given effective the second day of classes. A fine of \$2.00 is payable in the College business Office within 48 hours. If fines are not paid within the time limit, records will be encumbered and the fine will be increased to \$4.00. All fines must be paid before the student will be allowed to register for the next quarter. \*Parking spaces marked "Handicapped Parking" is reserved for Handicapped Visitors Only. Persons who park illegally in a Handicapped space will be subject to a \$1,000 fine as per recent state traffic law.
- A traffic control officer is on duty in order to aid you and to enforce all parking regulations.
- Students and Faculty/Staff having to drive a vehicle, other than their vehicle which has the parking sticker, for one or two days should see the traffic control officer and give him this information in order to not receive a parking ticket. They should park in the regular lot.

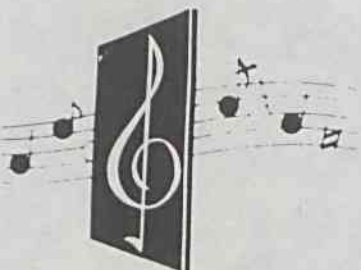


## Your New College Bookstore
