nents: red blood cells, platelets and plasma. Each component has specific uses:

Red blood cells carry oxygen from the lungs to every cell in the body. They are needed by patients in surgery or those who have lost blood in an accident or who have anemia.

Platelets help blood clot. Cancer patients need a lot of platelets to offset the effects of chemotherapy.

Plasma is used to control bleeding in certain patients and to make a variety of products, such as antihemophilic factor. More than half of blood is plasma.

Blood is needed for organ transplants, gastrointestinal disease, treatment of cancer, trauma, aneurysms, anemia, clotting disorders, premature babies, accident victims, open heart surgeries, and burns.

While only 5% of eligible people actually donate, it is estimated that 95% of us will need blood or a blood product during our lifetime. In our area, more than 1600 units of blood are needed each day for patients in local hospitals. You can donate blood every 56 days.
