A special thanks is extended to WKBC's Steve Handy who served as the host for this show and to WCC student, Matthew Warren, who served as the sound technician for this contest.



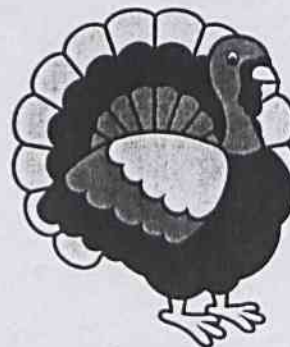
Mandy & Ryan perform "A Whole New World."
