

GUILFORD BEATS DUKE AND CATAWBA!

Woman's College was host for a statewide playday last Saturday, November 1, which saw colleges from all over the state competing in hockey, tennis, swimming, and archery. Guilford sent a hockey team and two tennis players.

The hockey games were run off in a round robin, each team playing every other team in a 12-minute game. Catawba, Duke, Greensboro College, Guilford, Salem, and Woman's College were the colleges represented in hockey.

The Guilford-Salem game was first on the schedule. The newness of surroundings and of playing against unfamiliar players hurt the Guilford team at the beginning, with the result that they came out on the tail and of a 1-0 score.

Improvement Shown

The same score was the result of the Woman's College-Guilford game, which was, nevertheless, a vast improvement over the loss of 5-0 to Woman's College last year.

In the mean time the team became used to the surroundings and

began to function as a unit. They had watched Duke play and caught on to some of their strengths and weaknesses. All these factors, plus the fact that Guilford was tired of being beaten, contributed to the victory over Duke a 2-1 score.

The Guilford girls drew Catawba as their next opponents and won 1-0.

The game with Greensboro College ended with a 0-0 score.

The results at the end of the day pronounced Salem winner of the hockey tournament with Duke and Woman's College tying for second place, and Guilford in third.

Guilford's team was chosen from the girls who had attended 5 out of the 7 WAA hockey practices. Those participating were as follows: wings—Inge Longerich, Julia White

Margie Anderson; inners—Charlotte Flanders, Beth Frederick, Barbara Blair; center—Marie Elliott; halfbacks—Sarah Farlowe, Jankie Williams, Betty Ray, Yvonne Dammann, Doris Cooper; fullbacks—Caroline Hopkins, Jane Pate, Marianne Victorious.

From all hockey players participating in the playday; seven were

chosen to be on an All-State Team. Of these seven, Inge Longerich and Marianne Victorious were chosen from Guilford.

Guilford's two tennis players were Jean Presnell and Flo Valer. Flo won over her ECTC opponent 6-2, but Jean lost to Greensboro College.
