# Quakers Rip Davidson

Last year Guilford College used homecoming as a springboard in turning around a dismal football program. This year the Quakers used the affair to embarrass Southern Conference opponent Davidson College 31-14. Billy Whitley, this weeks Athlete of the Week in the Greensboro Daily News, lead the win as he rushed for 80 yards while scoring three touchdowns, one on a pass from Steve Watson.

Both Whitley and defensive back Mike Ribet were named players of the week in the

Carolinas Conference. Ribet scored the second Quaker touchdown on a 85 yard scoring run after receiving a Wildcat punt.

Coach Dennis Haglan is beginning to sound like a broken record following a Guilford win. "Again it was nothing less than a team effort. Whitley, Watson and Chris Paphites each played well."

The Quakers rushed to a 14-0 lead before Davidson followed with a score after Ribet's punt return. Guilford scores came on a two yard run by Whitley and a 33 yard pass from Watson. Whitley again scored to produce a 21-7

halftime bludge.

Butch Foley added a 43 yard field goal in the third period to increase the lead to 24-7. Whitley then came back for his third score of the game in the fourth period, putting the game out of reach.

This marked the second week in a row that a Guilford player had scored three times in a game.

Only a late Davidson score helped produce the 17 point margin that was predicted in the Guilfordian last week.

The Quakers have the week off before visitint Wofford College in Spartanburg, S.C. The Guilford season now stands at an impressive 6-2-1.
