
Arcadia

Davidson **County Sheriff Gerald Hege says** that more charges are to come. Deputies found over 84 "highgrade" marijuana plants in Long's basement. Who's Who: Pope John Paul II



Name: Karol Joseph Wojtyla (pronounced Voy-tee-wah) Title: Pope John Paul II

Background: Born in 1920 to a Polish army officer and former schoolteacher in Wadowice, Poland, Pope John Paul II became the first non-Italian pope since 1523. He chose the name John Paul II to honor his predecessor John Paul I.


He is the most traveled pope in church history, having visited more than 100 countries by the year 2000. He was also the youngest pope in 132 years, and the only pontiff to ever have had a comic book featuring his life (Marvel Comics 1983).

speaks eight languages and was named "Man of the Year" in 1994 by Time Magazine. Mehmet Ali Agca attempted to assassinate the pope in 1981; he shot the pope twice in the abdomen.

In 2001 the church finally admitted that John Paul II was suffering from Parkinson's disease. He is best known for his love of human rights.
