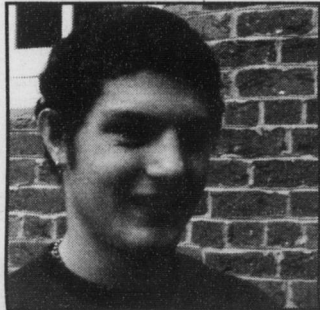

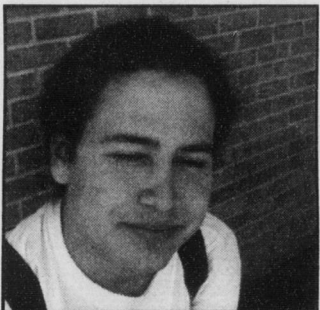
"I think they find the pettiest things to rag on each other about. They don't say what they are going to do for us if they become President."

Doug McConnell, Junior



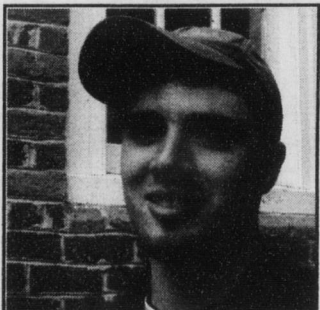
"I don't believe too much of politics. It's all the same bs to me from both sides."

Reynaldo Diaz, Junior



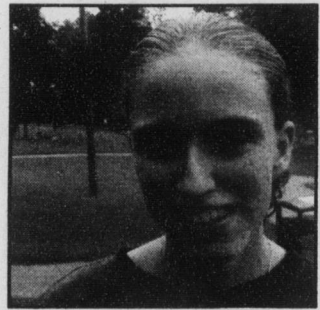
"It's basically just bashing each other. It's not going to help people decide who to vote for because it's not about real issues."
