President Fullor gave his annual message, followed by greetings from Miss Hannah Toitner, National Corresponding Secretary, and Dr. John W. Harris, National Secretary. The address of the evening was by Mr. Arthur Cundy of Birmingham, Alabama, Secretary of Civitan International. Mr. Arthyr Cundy was born in London, England, was a veterain of the World War, has been shipweecked twice, has addressed several hundred high schools and colleges throughout the U. S., and travoled the world

On Saturday morning at 8:00 a breakfast meeting was hold for the

principals and teachers with an address by Dr. Clydo A. Erwin.

Five hundred delegates took a tour of Raleigh at 10:30 A. M. At 11:00 A. M. the other six hundred delegates attended the picture, "Grapes of Wrath" at the Ambassador Theather.
