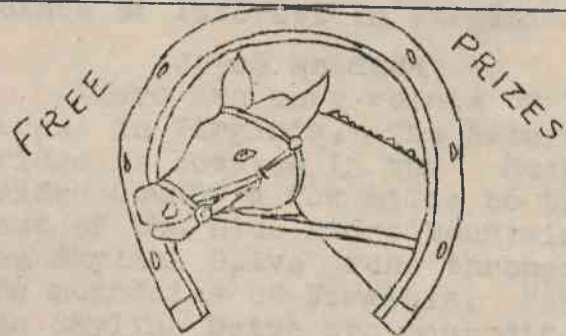
students, Phi Theta Kappa. The other is for the Commercial students, the Alpha Phi Epsilon.
