Dear Charles,

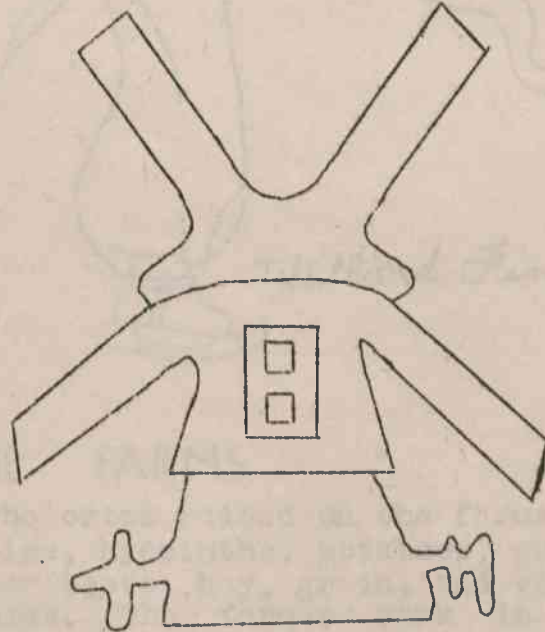
We enjoyed reading your letter. We know you have a good time playing on the slides and see-saws.
