### SHUFFLE - BOARD INTRODUCED

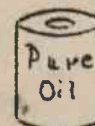
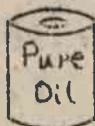
Approximately \$75 worth of equipment for the sports-minded students of Bailey High was purchased during the summer by the athletic coaches.
