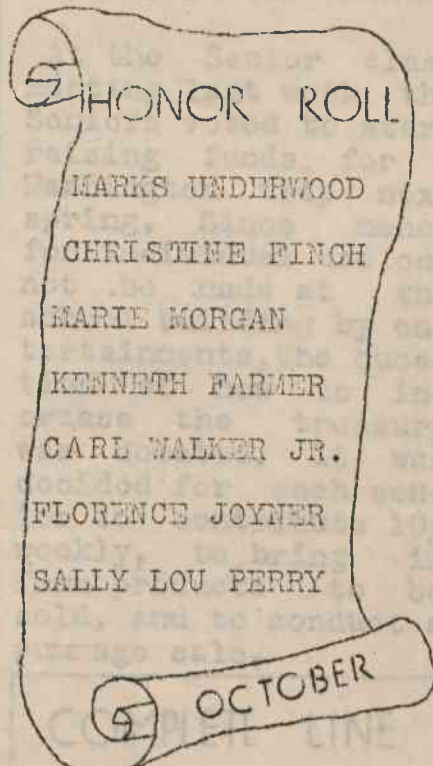
JUNIORS ADD \$26.70 TO TREASURY
