Number Of Lunches Served Increases

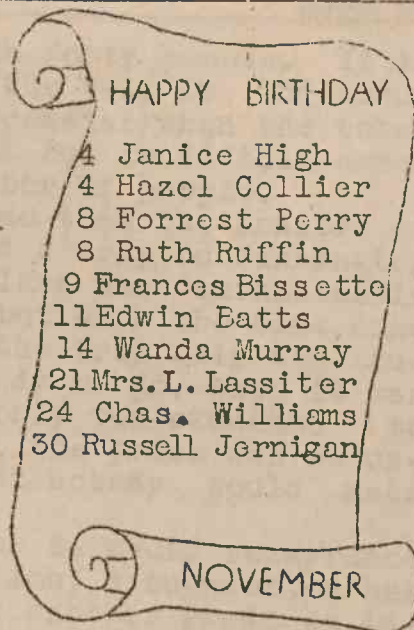
