FAVORITE type of book in the high school library proves to be fiction. More of these are issued each week than any other.

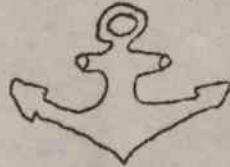
SCHOOL STORE, operated by Carl Walker Jr., is open every day before classes begin and during lunch.

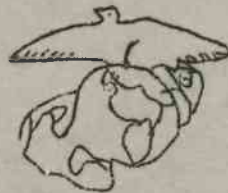
