### PURPOSE

The purpose of the School-Health Coordinating Service is to develop better practices and better teach. ing of health and physical education. Due to the fact that so many young mon called for the armed forces have been rejected, the problem is acute.

#### SUBJECTS

The subjects to be considered in the program are: 1. Health Service. 2. Health Instruction. 3. Healthful School Living. 4. Nutrition. 5. Physical Education.

Health Service includes screening and a determination of the defects of the students. The teachers will be instructed in just how to know if a child is well or sick. will also be a part of the health service program.

Health Instruction includos personal hygiono and safety and health habits.

Healthful School Living is the part that most vitally concerns each of us. In this program we are to consider the cleanlinoss and general appearance of the rooms, halls, toilcts, and grounds.

## NUTRITION

Nutrition is tho fourth item for discussion. The loaders will instruct in nutrition problems of children, proper lunchroom dicts and practices, and local dictary needs.

in the Physical Education program, consider-ation will be given to organization, mothods, and materials in the Physical Education program.
