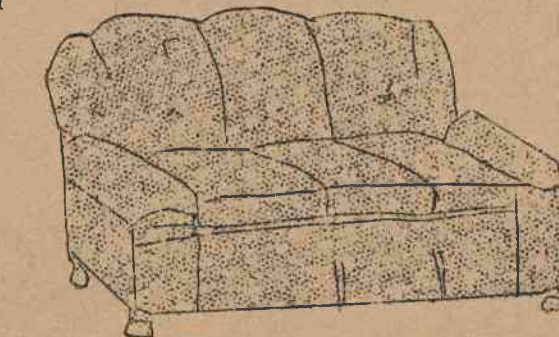

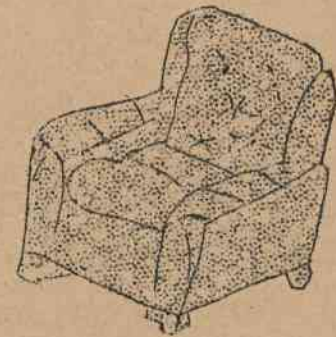


True Friendship Shown
