## Country Store, Countrymen's Club


Men in particular are by instinct gregarious. As proof, behold the popularity of a country store at night or on a snowy or rainy


Mr. M.W. Weaver asks that such complaints be reported to the school. If evidence indicates a new driver needed, a change will be made.
