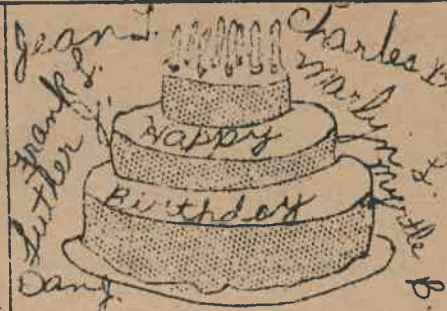
## FDA Officials Inspect Lunch Room Meals

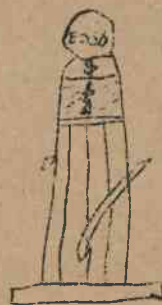

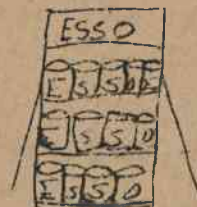
