Mr. Billy Cone built the first home and the store around 1886. 1888 brought the first school followed by the second school in 1900. For several years around 1906 the high school for the Bailey community was there. Mrs. Junior Wynne and Mr. S. E. Eure were the first teachers, Mr. Eure the principal. During the years 1938 and 1939 the present school was built. Glovers, the first post office, was built in the 1890's. The first two churches were frame buildings with logs to sit on. In 1903 the present church was started.

Mt. Pleasant now boasts a church, school, a dormitory, two stores, and several homes.

I have been unable to learn the origin of the name Mr. Pleasant or whether the community has always been so called. P. R. B.


