Only 43 boys and girls in high school have outstanding interests. The girls lead the boys in having favorite hobbies.

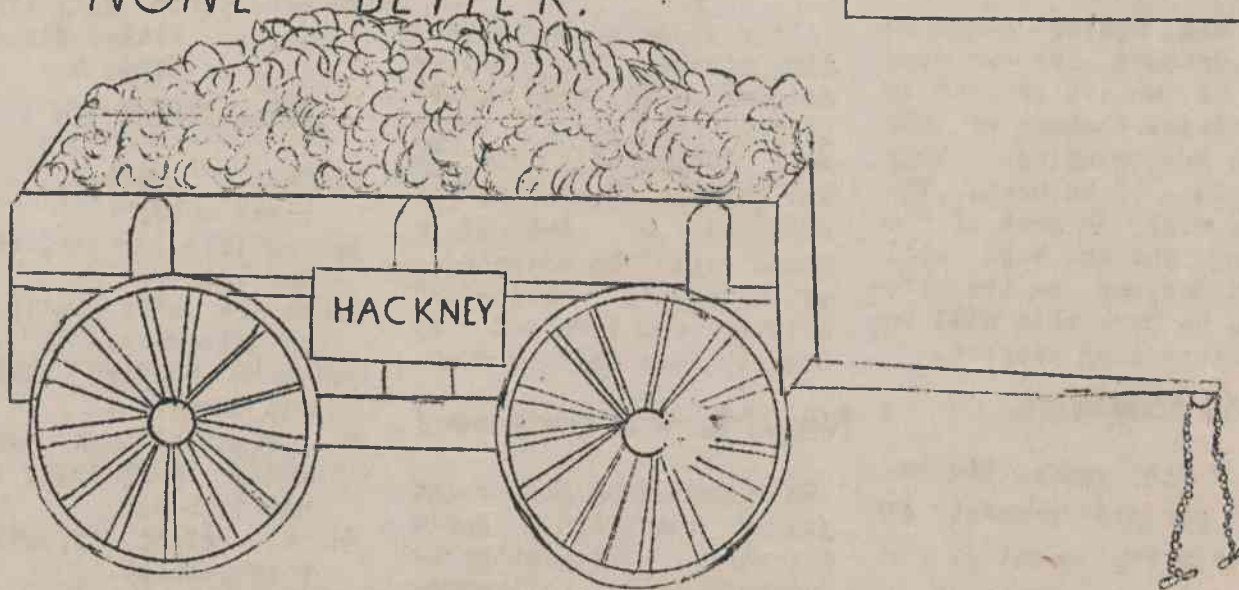
