# Baptist Sponsor Supper

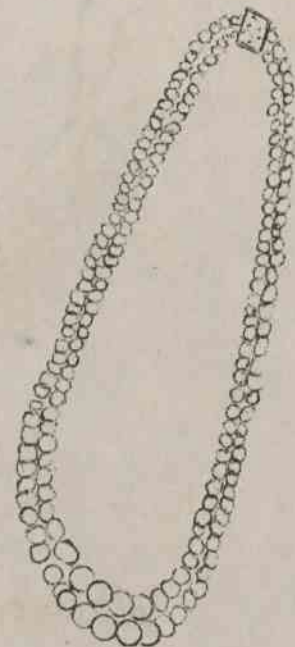
Members of the Baptist Missionary Society will serve a turkey supper tonight from six to eight o'clock at the Community Club House to raise money for the building fund.
