Although he is quite a man in size, Oscar is meek, quiet, and agreeable. Anything anyone does to him he takes good-naturedly.

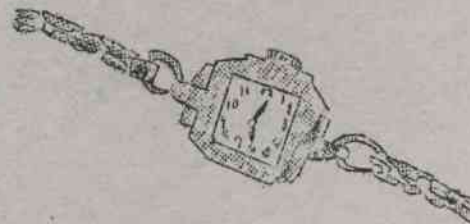
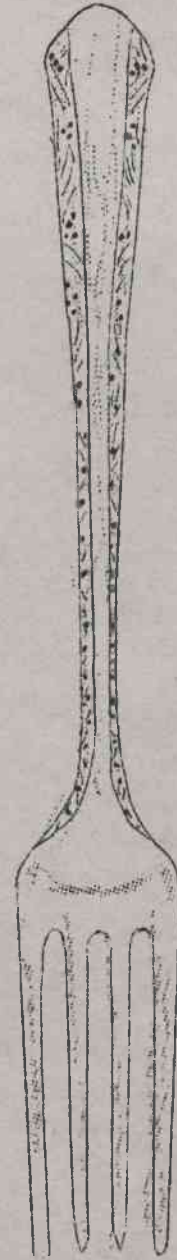
Oscar lets the girls study his physique and ask all questions they want regarding his sound body. They too want such a healthy body.
