

PTA To Sponsor Evening Program

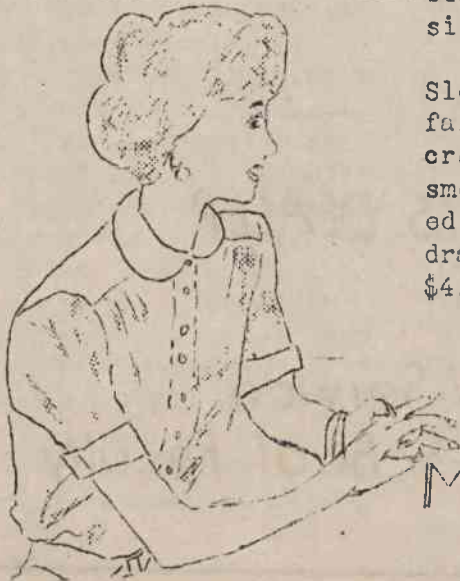
