Different types of ribbon matching the rest of the costume are worn by Eloise Bogen, seventh grader, to give the neat-attractive look.

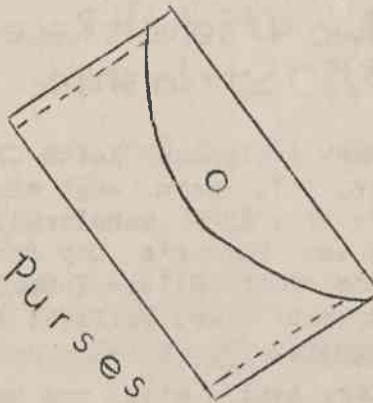
Matching the skirt or dress, hair bands of the same material are seen often.

Chambray, gingham, and taffeta cloth overrule the dress review.

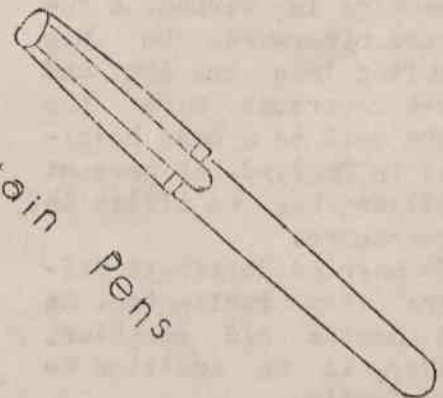
