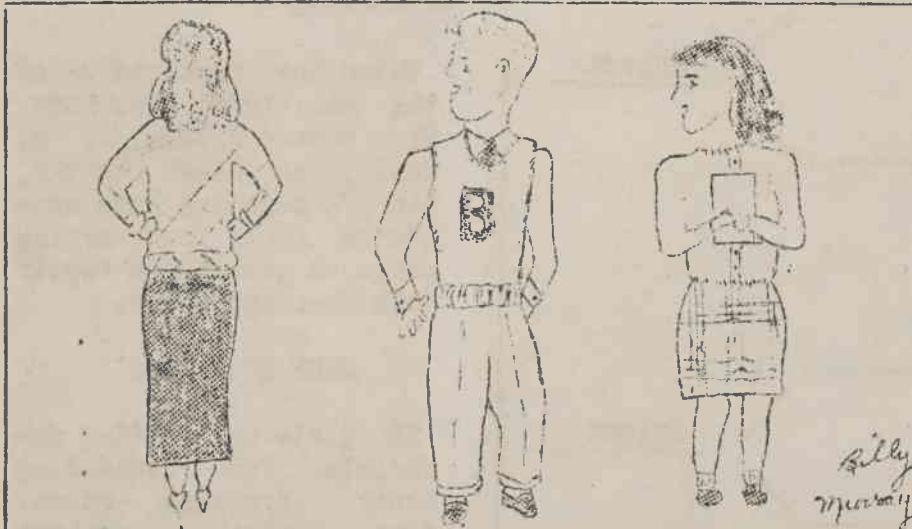


Fashions, Fancies, And Frills—By Bernease Eaton
