BILLS

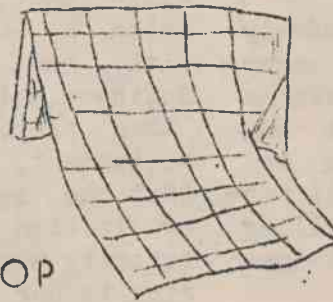
The total bills for the first month amounted to \$2,761.22.

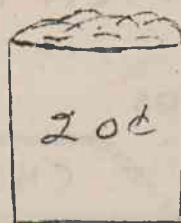
