After an article has been written, it is given to the student who is in charge of all articles of that particular type; as, Evelyn Poole, news; Beth Bissette, cclumns. These students correct the papers for the first time, and then they are turned in to Mrs. A. H. Farmer, Bugle advisor.

POINT SYSTEM

All papers are judged on a special point system, with points detracted each time a paper must be rewritten or is handed in late. Points are added for work done outside of class requirements. To get an "A" on journalism, a student must have at least 90 points.

Besides his class preparatory work and Bugle assignments, every student has extra duties. Some of these duties are mimeographing, proofreading, typing, and doing mimeoscope work.
