Plaster-----The bad places in the plaster have been repaired during the holidays.

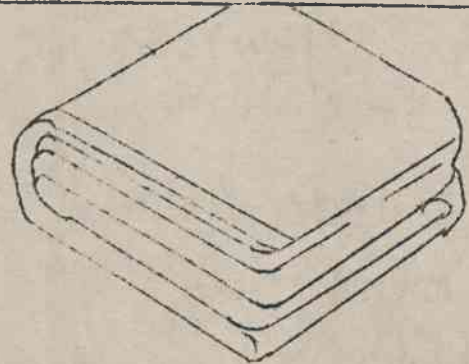
Good News-----Word has come that the new rooms will be ready for occupancy by February!
