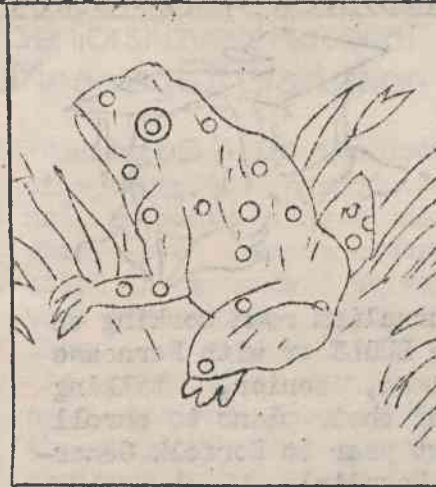
### Eighth Graders Collect Flowers Of North Carolina
