Mrs. Creech, Mrs. Murray, and Mrs. Pace visited the class on December 22, 1950.

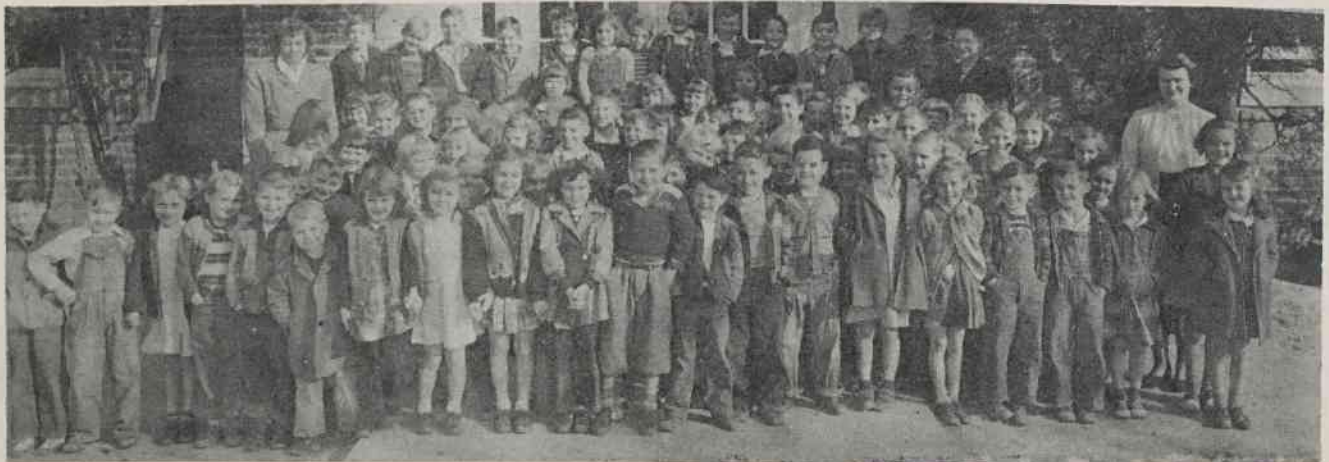
The pupils told the Christmas story and recited some verses from the Bible appropriate for Christmas.
