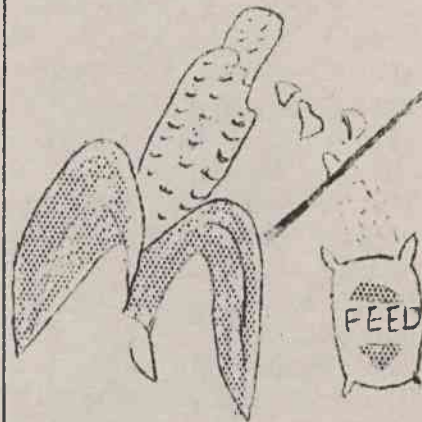
The class then presented a play, Ladies and Gentlemen, in which eight boys and girls imitated grown-ups.
