After the May 21 graduation, there will be a need for six new additional bus drivers for next year.

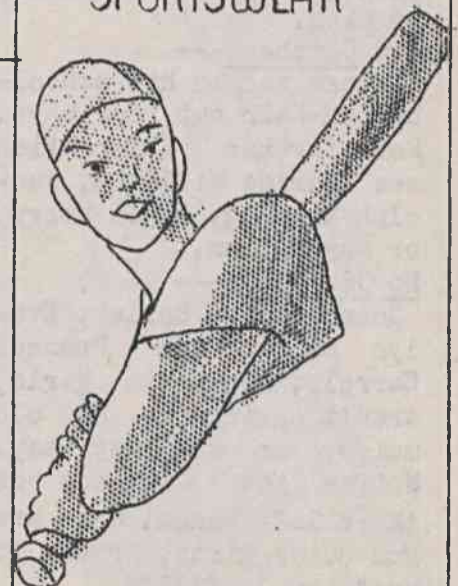
