A scout is a boy ready and willing to help any way he can.

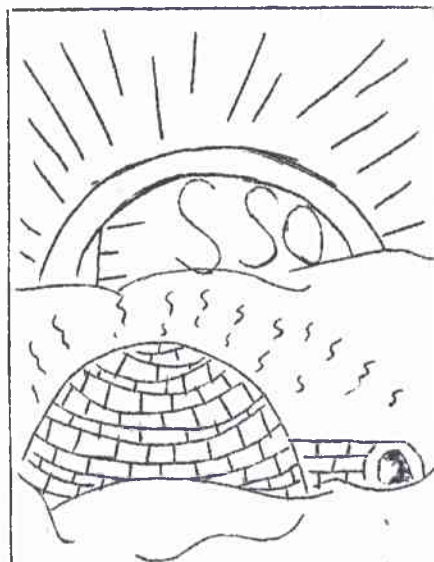
