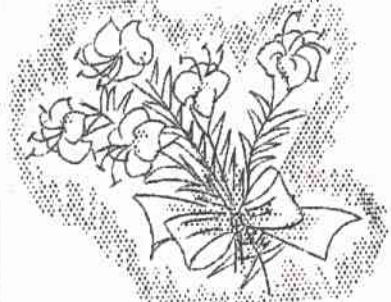
Completing the math lesson, we take up English. Of course it's nothing like Mrs. Farmer gives us seniors, but it's plenty rugged for a fourth grader.
