The annual Public Speaking Contest is April 23. Bailey has one representative.

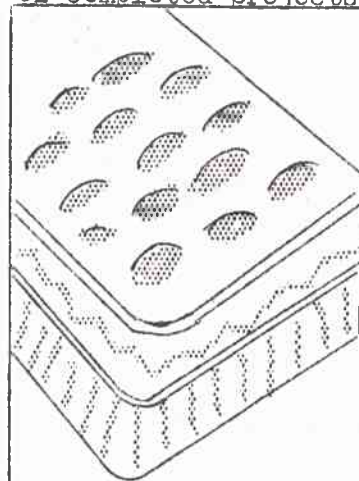
Roosevelt Warren and Dwight Glover are still getting praise for their excellent workmanship in building sink cabinets.
