

Committee Designate Amount For Cafeteria Use

Acting in behalf of the P.T.A. the executive committee of the organization decided to use all but \$100 of the funds in the treasury for helping to buy needed equipment for the new cafeteria.

At the last meeting of the P.T.A. members voted to so use the money and instructed the president to appoint a committee empowered to act for the association in deciding upon the amount to be allotted from the treasury.

The president appointed the executive committee to serve in this capacity.

ALLOCATION

At a meeting last week the committee decided that after all debts had been cleared to allocate the remainder of the funds above \$100 to the cafeteria. Needed equipment calls for around \$4,000.

At the present it appears that \$3,000 of this amount is in sight. The county, the P.T.A., and the lunch room will each pay approximately one-third of this amount.

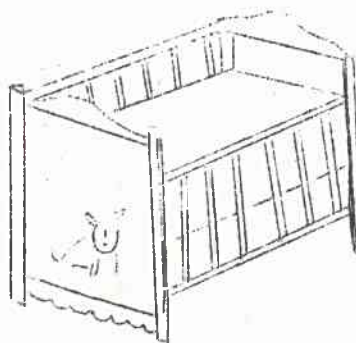
