GIRLS

The girls have a record of 2 wins, 5 loses, and 1 tie game. They have scored 497 points to the opponents' 502. They have made 142 fouls and have averaged a little more than 42 points a game.

FANNIE LOU MANNING has 82 field goals, 37 free throws, for a total of 201 points. She has made 17 fouls.
